









Thor Counter Stool

C	Front Footrest	1	
D	Back Footrest	1	
1	1/4 x 2 1/8 inch Hex Button Head Bolt	4 + Extra	
2	1/4 inch Lock Washer	4 + Extra	
3	1/4 inch Flat Washer	4 + Extra	
4	M4*40mm Screw	4 + Extra	
5	M10 x 25mm Wood Dowel	2 + Extra	
6	Allen Key	1

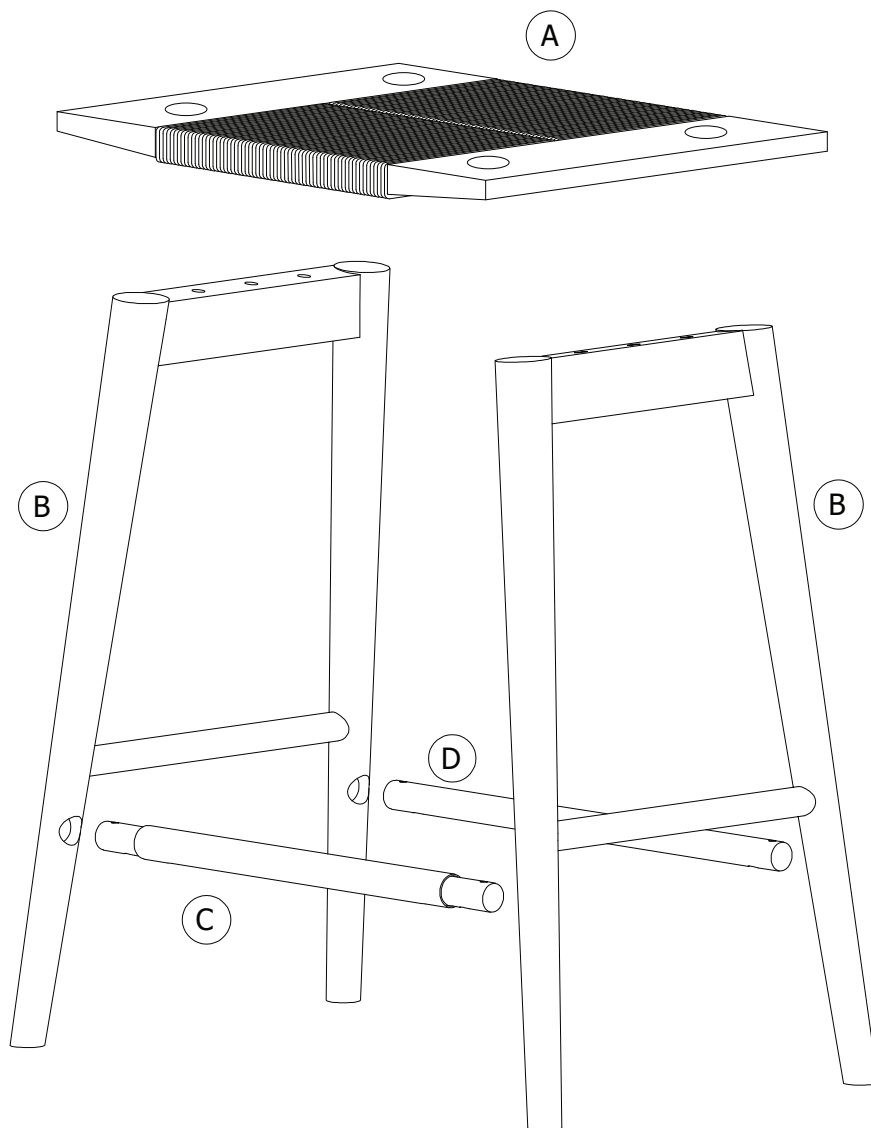
- Do not use power tools

IMPORTANT

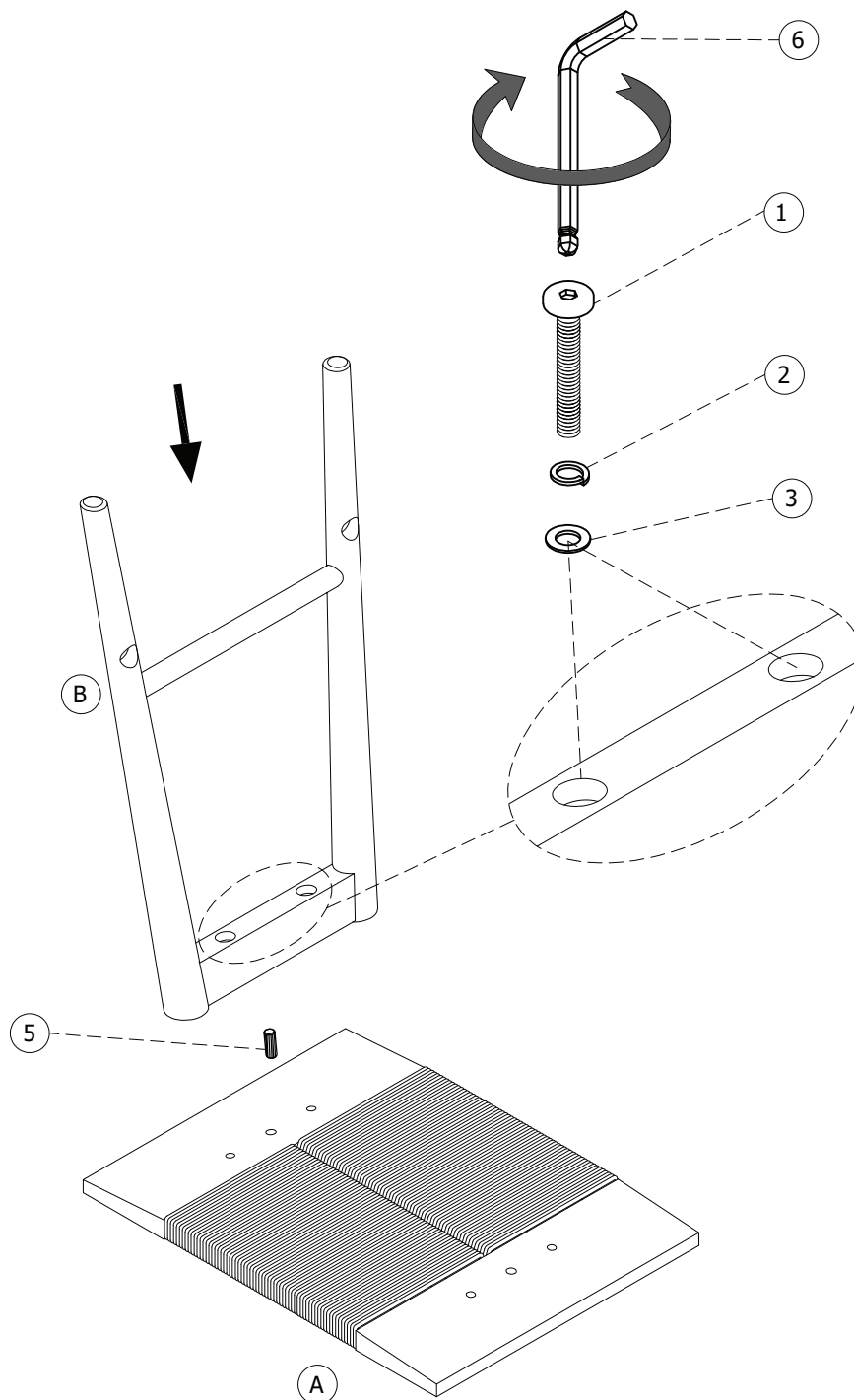
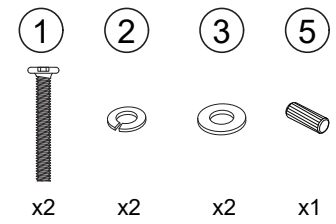
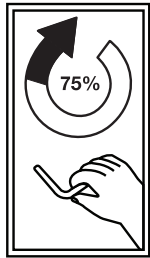
- Do not tighten bolts / screws completely until all bolts / screws are line up and inserted into holes
- Do not over tighten bolts to avoid stripping.
- Please use hand tools to assemble this product. Do not use power tools.

Step 1

Begin with the Left Legs (B), ensuring the footrest holes are oriented towards the center of the stool's seat platform.

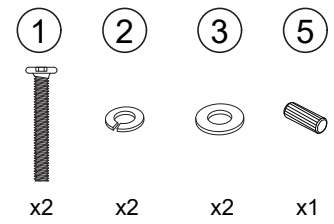
Use the lettered labels to align the components correctly.

Tighten all bolts to 75%.

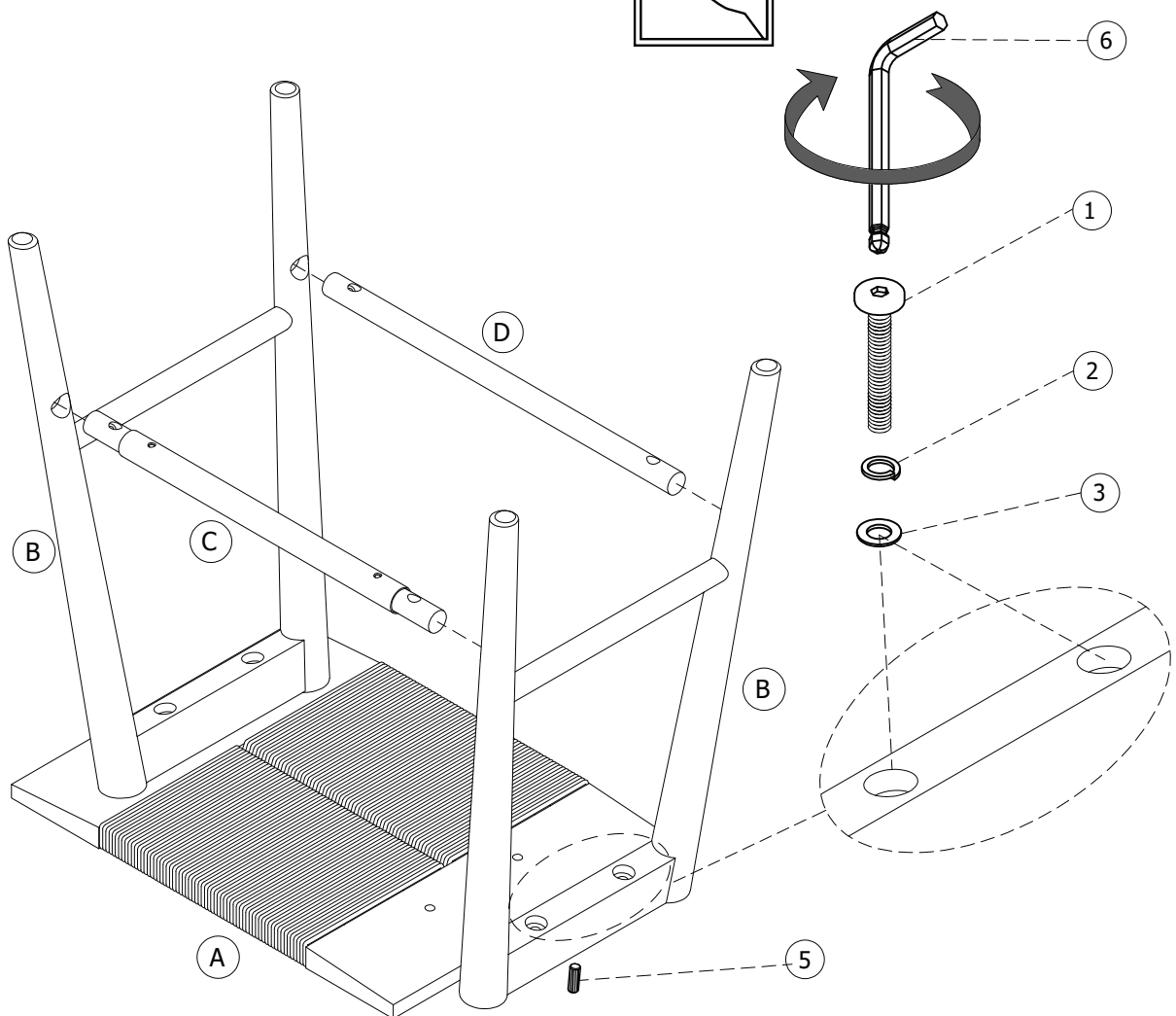
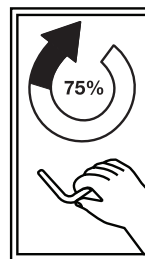


Step 2

Repeat Step 1 for the Right Legs (B), and at the same time,
attach the two footrests (front and back) between the two
sets of legs.

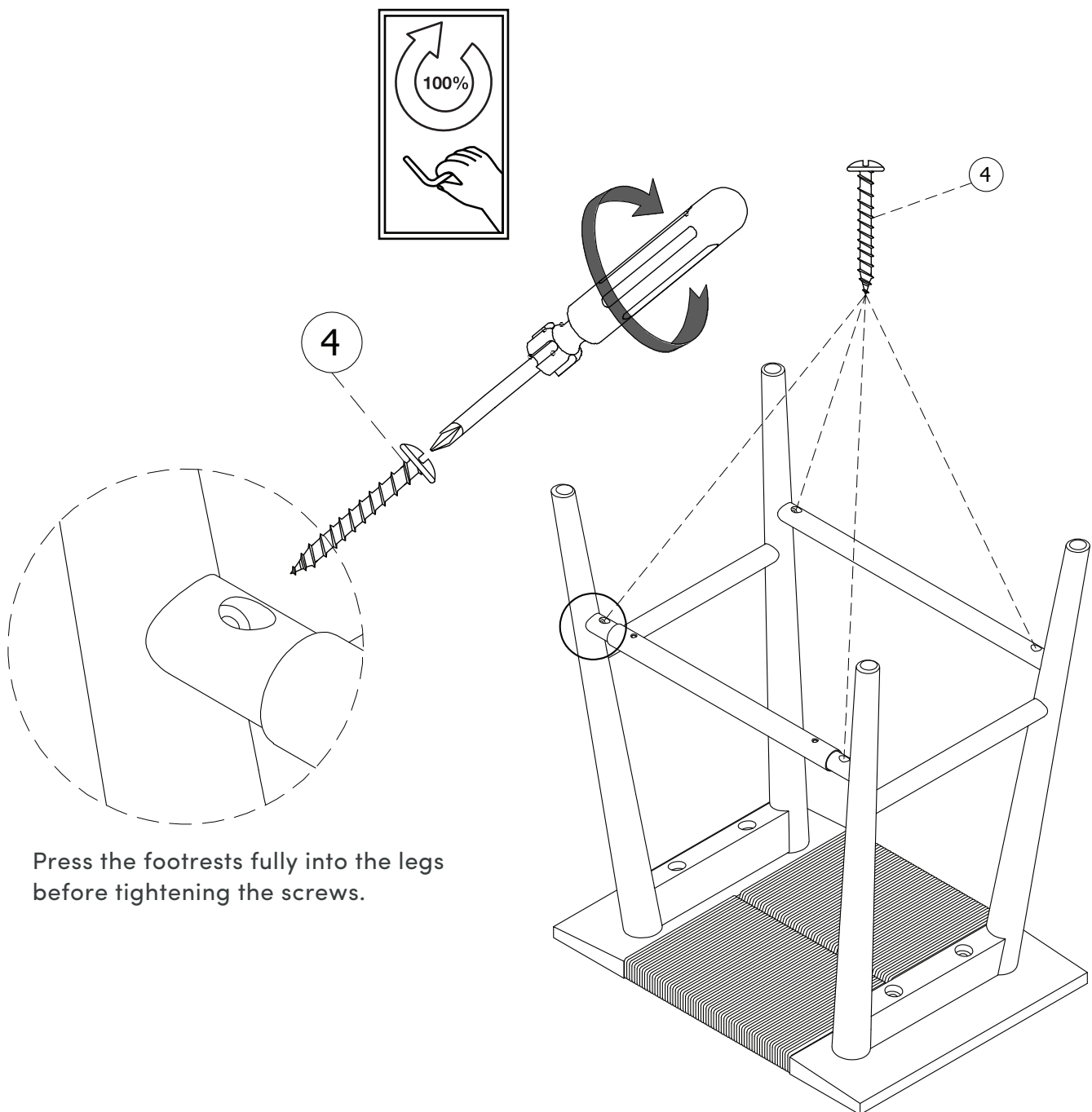


Donot overtighten bolts!



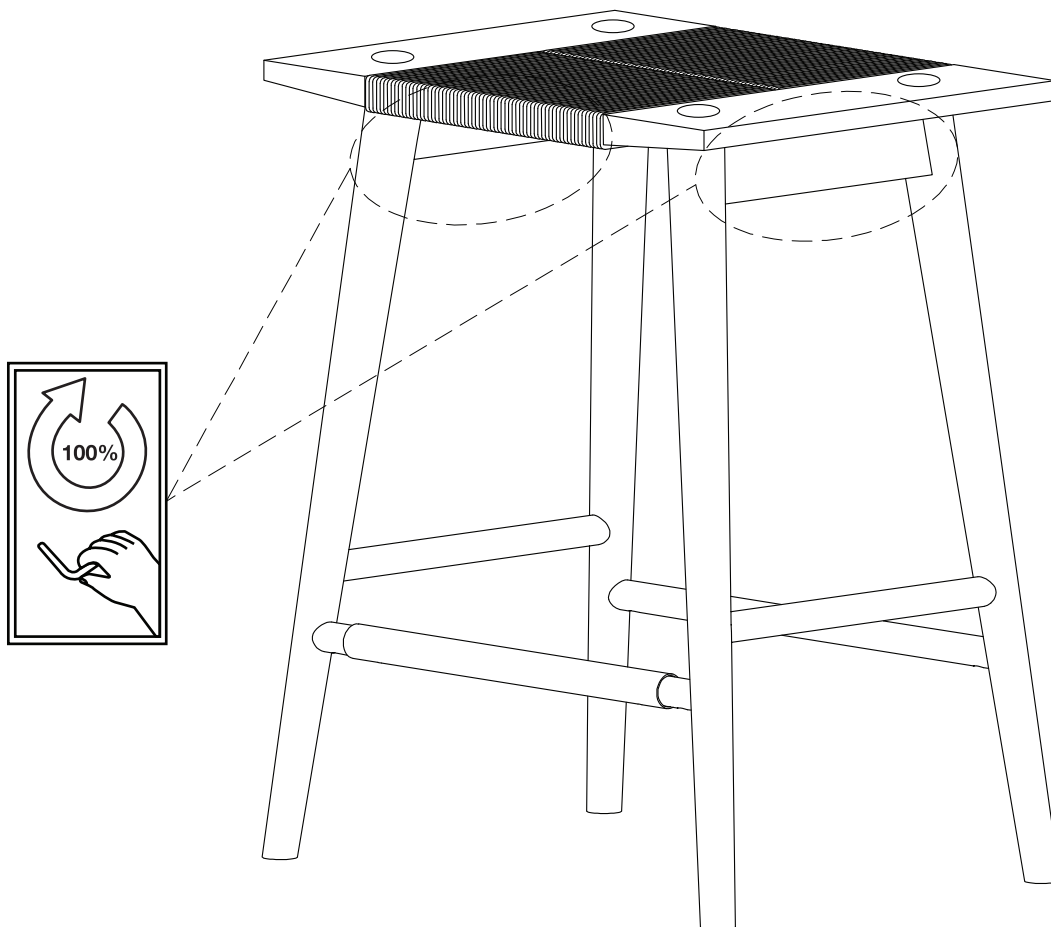
Step 3

Secure the footrests using the rounded head screws (4) and tighten them fully.

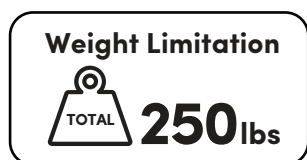
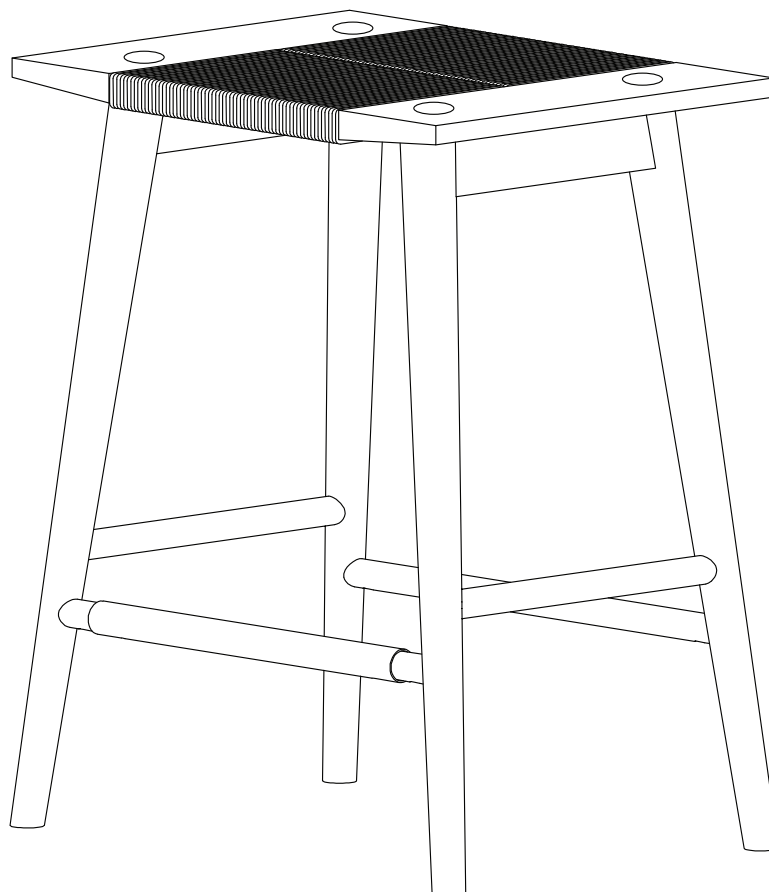


Step 4

Turn the stool upside down on a flat, level surface.
Ensure all legs are touching the ground before fully tightening everything
